Mayor Rankle opened the meeting and announced that we would have a 19% drop in our real estate tax rate this year. We had an increase of \$40,000,000 in property value of that \$8,000,000 was new growth.

Barb Tucker, Harry Tucker, and Martin Creutz were in attendance. Mr. Creutz asked if this increase in property value would affect the county rate? City Adm. Redmond said yes. Mr. Creutz said our county rate is really high compared to Ft. Thomas.

Mayor Rankle said he thinks the school rate will drop a little this year. But, the city has no control over the school rate. City Att. Fischer said in Dayton your school tax is on the county bill but in Ft. Thomas the school tax is on the city bill.
