MOBILE STORAGE UNIT PERMIT

Mobile Storage Unit Stored on Public Streets

I, Virgil L. Boruske, Mayor of the City of Dayton, Kentucky, pursuant to KRS 83A.080 hereby order the following regulations be adopted:

1. Mobile Storage Units may be permitted to remain on a public street immediately adjacent to the address it is meant to serve, only if it is found that there is no feasible method to store same on the owner's property.
2. Mobile Storage Units stored on the street shall not exceed 96 inches in width or 38 feet in length and shall be placed in such a manner as to have the least possible impact on traffic flow. Such dumpsters shall not be permitted on narrow streets if the dumpster would impede traffic flow.
3. Mobile Storage Units stored on a public street not longer than 72 hours. Successive permits shall not be granted unless certified by the City Administrator that the removal work being performed cannot be accomplished in within 72 hours.
4. Applicant shall submit an application indicating the address where the dumpster is to be stored; the name, address and phone number of the company providing dumpster services, expected date of placement; reason for services and any other information required to determine appropriateness of issuance of permit. Application shall be made at least 48 hours prior to placement for review purposes. Application shall be reviewed by the Blight Administrator and Fire Department Official.
5. Applicants shall submit a bond in the amount **\$75.00** to insure that the dumpster will be removed within 72 hours and that the public property surrounding the dumpster is left in a clean and sanitary condition. In the event that the dumpster is not removed within 72 hours, the City shall order the removal and shall pay for same from the bond submitted. In the event that the area surrounding the dumpster is not left in a clean and sanitary condition, the City shall clean the area and charge all costs and a reasonable additional fee against the bond. Any amounts of the bond not used for these purposes shall be returned to the applicant.
