**Administration Overview**

On Tuesday I hosted a sub-committee of Northern Kentucky City Managers to discuss issues we are all facing in terms of budgets and rising costs. Shortly after I met with the KLC President and several members of the KLC board to further these discussions and what KLC might do to assist us.

I met with Manhattan Harbour developers several times this week to work through some challenges and to get progress updates on future projects.

I also spoke with KYTC about doing another traffic study, this time while school was in session, so we could analyze the 6<sup>th</sup> and Berry Intersection. They are going to perform this study in September and hopefully will be willing to discuss our idea of testing a 4-way stop.

I want to thank our Public Works crew for working tirelessly through the huge storm that blew through on Tuesday evening. Rick and I spent a great deal of time discussing the issues in the community and we will continue to work with the Task Force on some next steps in our endeavor to take this matter very seriously.

As I mentioned to you last week our trash schedule will be changing this fall. Once I get final approval from Republic we will release the full information to the public.

Lastly, Bob was given official approval to move into the ROW phase of our major sidewalk project!

- **Manhattan Harbour:**
  - Nothing new to report.

- **Riverfront Commons (Construction Phase):**
  - Ribbon Cutting Ceremony to officially open the RFC trail is set for August 8<sup>th</sup> at 6PM.
- **Sidewalk Improvement Project (Design Phase):**
  - Final approval was granted to move on to ROW phase.
- **New City Building Project**
  - SHP began their study into an adaptive re-use option for a city building. The study is expected to take 6-10 weeks.
