#### **Overview**

\*\*Due to the New Year's Holiday, the January City Council Meeting will be held on Wednesday January 2nd at 7:00PM at the School Administration Building.

It was a very busy end to the year. Special thanks for all the Civic Club members and all the other volunteers who put on an outstanding Light-up-Dayton event.

Prus Construction was awarded the construction bid for Phase I riverfront commons. We are working on a contract and work should begin on the project in the spring.

A financial analysis was completed on the KZF Design report for a new City Building and distributed to the Council.

Ben and I attended a year end Southbank update with various other cities and officials. The evening recapped several development projects and Riverfront Commons updates in each city. As previously mentioned Dayton has received full funding for our portion of the trail and we just selected Prus Construction to complete the first phase of construction next spring.

We reached an agreement with Bluegrass Paving to rectify some troubled areas from the fall paving project. We have documented the areas of concern (mostly on Rose Drive and 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue) and will monitor them through the winter months. In the spring Bluegrass will come back and fix these issues.

We have finally been given the green light to enter into a contract for Right-of-Way acquisition for the sidewalk grant along Dayton Pike. Bob is working on getting everything set for the contract. We have decided to go with Dunrobin Associates, which is a local firm that specializes in this particular area. We hope to wrap up this phase as quick as possible so we can put the construction bid out when the weather is nice in 2019.
