Administration Overview

I met with a KYTC representative from the Governors office on Monday to address additional road funding needs that need to be addressed outside the scope of our normal revenue that comes in to fix our streets. I don't expect anything to come out of the meeting in terms of additional funds allocated to the City, but I was also able express frustration I've had with our local KYTC office regarding Rt 8.

The ribbon cutting ceremony at Unataza had a great turn out and I've noticed a good stream of patrons going in an out of the shop this week. Best of luck to them in their new endeavor.

We could potentially see a lot of movement with Manhattan Harbour in the next couple of months. There are several sites that are under contract looking to close, but there are still a lot of moving parts to figure out in terms of the financing. I hope to have good news to share in the coming month.
