## **Overview**

As previously reported, Republic Services will be updating the trash schedule in both the City of Dayton. The change will take place on **October 14th.** Dayton residents will still receive trash pick-up **ONCE PER WEEK** but your date of service will be either Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday based on location. An interactive link has been posted on our website under "Latest News."

NKY Water District is performing a major water main replacement on Ervin Terrace. This will be a tedious project that is expected to last several months. Please use alternative routes during construction unless necessary.

Rick and I met KYTC, SD1 and NKY Water on Rt. 8 to discuss many hillside water issues plaguing residents, businesses and the road. The meeting was productive, and we were able to identify who was responsible for each of the respective issues. Rick and I will continue to follow up to ensure the work gets done.

I met with a KYTC representative from the Governor's office on Monday to address additional road funding needs that need to be addressed outside the scope of our normal revenue that comes in to fix our streets. I don't expect anything to come out of the meeting in terms of additional funds allocated to the City, but I was also able express frustration I've had with our local KYTC office regarding Rt 8.

We could potentially see a lot of movement with Manhattan Harbour in the next couple of months. There are several sites that are under contract looking to close, but there are still a lot of moving parts to figure out in terms of the financing. I hope to have good news to share in the coming month.
