ADMINISTRATIVE SUMMARY

Overview

The October 8th Special City Council Meeting is available to view online.

Rick Lucas met with Riegler Paving this week to discuss the concerns brought up by council last week regarding the work completed on Ervin Terrace and Belmont. They understand the issues related to the catch basin on Belmont and are putting a plan together to fix. We also looked at the catch basin at the corner of Ervin and Belmont. There is some minor blacktop work needed on that area, but the City will look to improve the curb for better water control.

Back in August some regional leaders presented SD1 with a scope of services for identifying and proposing solutions to local storm water issues that are plaguing our communities. This week SD1 provided a response to that meeting that will help us fine-tune the scope to eliminate any work already completed by SD1. The regional communities will communicate on amending the scope of services and will hopefully continue to work towards presenting a possible project that will create a game plan on mitigating these issues.
