

CITY OF DAYTON, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-#2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PENALTY FOR
VIOLATION OF CHAPTER 157 OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES, REGISTRATION OF VACANT REAL
PROPERTY.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DAYTON,
CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

That the following sections shall be amended in the Code of Ordinances for the City of Dayton:

§157.99 PENALTY.

(A) Any creditor of vacant, foreclosed real property or owner of vacant real property that fails to register such property with the City Clerk/Treasurer shall be subject to a civil fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) [~~for each day of the violation~~]. Payment of this fine shall count as a credit or set off to any unpaid or outstanding Registration Fee required herein.

(B) Failure to maintain accurate information once having registered the property shall constitute a violation and shall be subject to a civil fine [~~of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each day of the violation~~] in accordance with the City's Civil Fine Schedule.

Section II

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication as is required by law.
